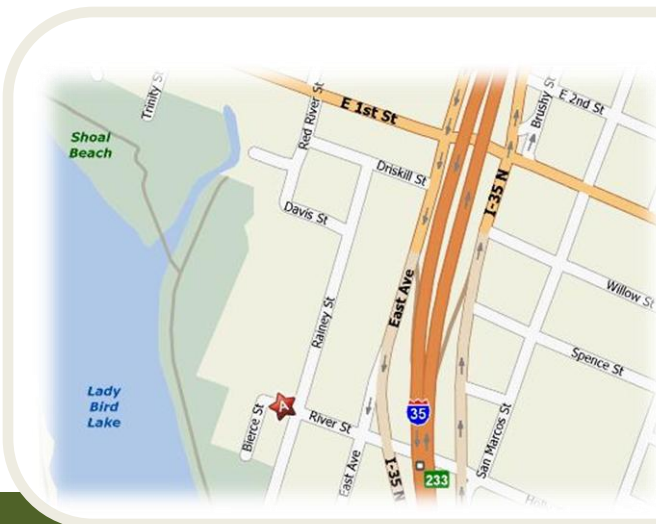


Did you know....
